ON THE APPLICATION of the Plaintiff coming on for hearing at the Courthouse, 800 Smithe Street, Vancouver, BC, on 25/Oct/2023 and on hearing Michelle Segal for the Plaintiff;


AND ON BEING ADVISED THAT Class Counsel has reserved all rights to re-attend before this Court to seek approval of the remaining Class Counsel fees payable pursuant to the terms of the retainer agreement entered into with the plaintiff;

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. Class Counsel's legal fees in the amount of \$7,750,000 (the "**Fee Amount**"), plus applicable taxes, and disbursements of \$35,942.61, plus applicable taxes, are approved;
2. Class Counsel's legal fees, disbursements and applicable taxes shall be paid from the settlement funds, pursuant to the terms of the settlements entered into with:
 - (a) ROHM Co. Ltd, and ROHM Semiconductor U.S.A., LLC., dated September 13, 2022,
 - (b) Fujitsu Ltd. and Fujitsu Canada, Inc., dated December 15, 2022,
 - (c) KEMET Corporation, and KEMET Electronics Corporation, dated January 31, 2023,
 - (d) Nichicon Corporation and Nichicon (America) Corporation, dated March 31, 2023, and
 - (e) Nippon Chemi-Con Corporation and United Chemi-Con, Inc., dated July 14, 2023,(the "**Settlement Agreements**");
3. the payment of the Fee Amount will be structured as follows:
 - (a) \$6,250,000, plus applicable taxes, to be paid on the Effective Date of the Settlement Agreements, and
 - (b) \$1,500,000, plus applicable taxes, to be held back and paid upon further order of this Court;
4. this Order is contingent upon approval of the Settlement Agreements by the Ontario Court and the Quebec Court, and approval of the requested legal fees, plus applicable taxes, and disbursements, plus applicable taxes, by the Ontario Court, and that the terms of this Order shall not be effective unless and until such orders are made; and

5. endorsement of this Order by counsel for the Defendants shall be dispensed with.
